

2020 INDIVIDUAL TAX RETURN CHECKLIST

Here's a checklist to help you prepare the information for your tax return.

Income

Payment summaries (previously called Group Certificates). Note for 2019/20 onwards your employer may not give you a copy of these but rather you will access on MyGov.
Centrelink statement for Newstart Allowance, Pension payments, Austudy, Youth Allowance, Parenting Payment (Partnered). Again these will be accessible on your MyGov account. We do not require details of your Family Tax Benefit Payments
Bank interest Earned
Dividends received
Rental income (refer to separate checklist)
Annual distribution and tax statements for Managed Funds
Purchase & sale details for investments sold including shares. This should include the date of purchase & sale & the cost and sale amounts

Motor Vehicle Expenses

Do you use your car for work purposes other than travelling directly to and from work ? This may include visiting suppliers/customers, picking up materials, attending external training. You can claim using one of 2 methods below.
If you have prepared a log book then provide a copy of the log book along with all running costs for the motor vehicle for the 2019/20 year, ie petrol, registration, insurance, servicing, RAA membership, car wash. Include cost and date the vehicle was purchased.

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Alternatively advise the number of **kilometres travelled for work** for the 2019/20 year - up to a maximum of 5,000 km. Note this generally excludes travel directly from home to work and from work to home.

Other Work-related Expenses

Did you use your mobile phone for work purposes during the 2019/20 year? If yes advise your total phone cost for 2019/20 along with your business use percentage.
Did you undertake any work from home during the 2019/20 year? If yes advise the average number of hours per month that you worked from home.
Did you use your home internet for work purposes? If yes, then advise your total home internet cost for the 2019/20 year along with work use percentage.
Do you wear a compulsory work uniform ? Typically, this would be embroidered with your work details. If yes advise amount spent on these items for 2019/20.
Do you wear protective clothing for work, ie steel capped boots, high vis clothing, safety glasses? If yes advise amount spent on these items for 2019/20.
Do you use any other electronic devices for work – ie computer, iPad. If yes then advise date you purchased the item, cost and work use percentage
Did you undertake any study during the 2019/20 year which has a connection to your work activities? If yes then advise all study expenses incurred during 2019/20 including course fees, books, stationery
Other work-related expenses include Union Fees, Professional Subscriptions, Professional Magazines, Tools

Other Information

Details of any gifts or donations
Details of income protection insurance paid.
Details of last year's tax return fee if not MCG Accountants.
Annual private health fund statement
If you have a partner or spouse – their name, dob and taxable income
Any other information you may think is relevant. Each person's circumstances are unique

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
